THE BIRTH AND EARLY YEARS OF WEST COAST Women's ULTIMATE 1977-1985

As part of my <u>www.ultimatehistory.com</u> website, I am compiling information about the very early years of women's Ultimate on the West Coast including California, Oregon and Washington teams and players. Please let me know if you can add or correct anything.

History:

The first time there was an all womens game in California was in 1977. The only Ultimate competition at that time was between men's Ultimate teams from L.A. (Foothill) and Santa Barbara (Condors). In Santa Barbara and in L.A., women played with the men at practices. This was in fact the case around the country at that time. Any women who were playing played coed on men's teams. At one of the L.A./S.B. get-togethers in August 1977, we decided to have just the women play each other -- we had just enough on both sides to do that. Our team had about 9 women and theirs about the same. SB won. In 1979 we had another at a Cal States tournament, where women from Southern CA (SB+LA) and women from Northern CA had an informal game. We did this again in Santa Cruz in 1980. Between 1978-1980, I remember players like--Lynn Tabor, Shelly Barclay, Suzanne Bingam, Ann Avery, Laura Shepherd, Dana Lewis, Chisty Ground, Cindy Bourgie, et al.

The Women's Division in the UPA, and thus the first UPA Women's National Championship, didn't come about till 1981. At a meeting in a swimming pool in Irvine, CA in August 1981, I, Suzanne Fields and Louie Mahoney proposed a women's division to the UPA coordinators including TK (UPA's Managing Director). They agreed. Sandy Ross and I were able to gather almost 20 women for the SB team for '81 Regionals mostly from the intramural teams that were pretty popular; so we had lots of interest, some good basic athletic ability, but very little experience. Women from mostly Eugene and Seattle formed NW Synergy who beat SB in the finals to be the first women's Western Regional Champions and go to Nationals.
